Press Release 2/10: New golf tee design has extra performance features.

Lower resistance golf tees can add distance and accuracy to your drives. Stiff peg style tees can actually decelerate your club head just before it releases the ball, robbing distance and accuracy. The D-tee from Distancetee is your best choice in low resistance tees. The D-tee only flexes in the direction you're club-head is moving, so that it maintains strength and grip friendliness. Simply insert tee in the ground with the wide, flat side facing the target.

An alternate method of insertion is with the slender, knife like edge towards the target. This achieves less resistance than a standard tee as well by knifing through the ground as the club contacts the ball. Golfers seem split, with both groups saying the method they use produces the optimum results.

The D-tee is made of a high strength polycarbomate so it lasts a long time. A bag of 16 tees should last the average golfer longer than 200 standard tees, making it environmentally friendly. The D-tee comes in a compact red drawstring pouch, which stays closed and is easy to find in your golf bag. Also, it is shipped in a recycled paper padded envelope that can be recycled again.

With it's oversized head and flexible shaft par three iron shots will get all the loft and spin your club was designed to achieve. The blade like shaft of the distance tee is the golfer's best tool of choice. Scrape the dirt from your club-face with the nonabrasive edge, or clean the grooves with the tip. There is no better ball mark fixer you can use on the green.
